GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

IMPORTANT

-  ID card provided by the institution or letter of authorization from the head of the institution / department should be sent along with the entries to the email ids provided. If the candidate is participating for more than one event, the proof of identity should be attached with each of the entries separately.
-  The competition is only for +1 and +2 students and UG students only.

- Every contestant group or individual should report at the respective platform **15 minutes** before the time announced. Failure to report in time will lead to cancellation of the group's or individual's registration.
- It is the sole responsibility of the respective candidates to ensure that the necessary logistics (functioning internet, laptops / mobile phones, speakers, microphones etc) are set up prior to the time announced.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- Communication with the teams shall be through the registered email id only. No other means will be entertained.
- All the participants are required to wear ID cards provided by their respective institutions at the time of registration.
- Kindly follow the instructions given by the coordinators to ensure the smooth conduct of the program. You are requested to seek the advice of official volunteers, in case any assistance is required, using the registered to the given email ids.
- Any kind of vulgarity / profanity / abuse will be penalized and the candidate will be immediately disqualified.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

Your grievances, if any, will be considered with due importance. Grievance regarding any matter may be reported to **splendore@rajagiri.edu** , in writing, within 30 minutes of the declaration of results. The Grievance Redressal Cell will convene and rule on the grievance within two hours of filing of the grievance. Only the grievances submitted by the Group Leader will be taken for consideration by the cell. The decisions of the Grievance Redressal Committee shall be final.

GENERAL RULES CONCERNING THE COMPETITIONS

1. Order of presentation of an event

- 👉 Lots will be taken to decide the order in which the teams will perform.
- 👉 Only the organisers are granted the authority to change the order to facilitate the participation of members in subsequent events (if any).

2. Reporting at the venue

- 👉 The links to participate in the events will be sent to the concerned candidates 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the event.
- 👉 Teams should be present at the concerned platform 15 minutes before the announced time of the event.

3. Evaluation criterion:

- 👉 Each event participated will be evaluated based on the criteria specified.

4. Judgement

- 👉 The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

5. Participation

- 👉 The number of participants for the events will be only according to the numbers specified against each event.
- 👉 Participation certificates will be issued to all the participants.

6. Registration

1. 4 November 2020 will be the last date to register for the competitions. The registration form can be access form <http://www.splendorercss.in/>
2. There is NO REGISTRATION FEE.
3. The participants will be given chest numbers for the final round of the competitions. The chest numbers should be visibly worn during performance.

DETAILED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR COMPETITIONS

Event 1: *GRANDS GÉNIES* (Quiz)

Number of participants per team: 1

1. The competition will have two rounds ; the qualifiers and the finals.
2. Preliminary round/s will be conducted via online platform to decide on the final four.
3. **The time and link to join the preliminary competitions will be sent to the registered candidates on 5 November 2020.**
4. In case of tie, tie breaker rounds will be resorted to.
5. Only qualifying candidates will appear for the final round.
6. The finals will comprise five rounds.
7. **The date, time and link to join the finals will be sent to the selected candidates to the registered email ids.**

Note:

If the number of teams registering for the event is less than three, the event will be held but only consolation prizes will be awarded to the participants.

Event 2: TABLEAUX VIVANTS (Live Portrait)

Number of participants per team: 1

1. There will be only one round (live) for this competition.
2. Theme will be given on the spot.
3. The allotted time is 90 minutes.
4. The size of the painting should not be less than an A4 (A4 sheets, chart and art paper can be used)
5. Only pencil, scale, drawing paper and crayons / color pencils may be used.
6. The painting to be submitted should be a .jpeg file.
7. No edits, no filters are allowed.
8. The painting will be judged based on the adherence of the art work to the theme given.
9. It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ensure the necessary logistics and internet connectivity.
10. **The date, time and link to join the competitions will be sent to the registered candidates to the registered email ids.**

If the number of teams registering for the event is less than three, the event will be held but only consolation prizes will be awarded to the participants.

Event 3: HOMME D’AFFAIRES (Business Presentation Competition)

Maximum number of participants per team: 3

No change in team structure will be permitted after the team is registered.

PHASE 1: Submission Round

Guidelines for the Submission:

1. Every participating team must submit their Business Idea as an MS Word document.
2. A team can make only ONE entry (one Business Idea).
3. Each team must clearly mention their topic, names of the team members, institution name in your mail and also on the cover page of the document.
4. Images and infographics may be used only with due acknowledgement of the sources.
5. No request to extend the deadline will be entertained.
6. The entries should be sent to the mentioned email ids on or before **5.00 pm on 08-11-2020.**

The Business Plan should have the following contents:

- An introduction to the Plan / Idea
- The Opportunity (Uniqueness)
- Summary of Market Analysis (Customer Needs, Reach and Delivery)
- Execution Process (Marketing Plan, Sales Plan, Logistics and other Infrastructure)
- Financial Expenses (Startup Expenses and Capitalization)
- Anticipated challenges and proposed solutions
- The Document should use Times New Roman Font, Font Size 12 and 1.5 Line Space

The Top SIX Teams will be selected based on the submission. The submissions will be evaluated based on the Uniqueness, Marketability and Financial Viability of the Idea.

PHASE 2: Final Round

The Top SIX Teams will be invited to present their Business Plans along with their Product Launch videos.

Guidelines for the Presentation and Product Launch Video:

1. The final phase of the event will be conducted live via online platform.
2. Scheduled Time for each Team will be intimated through e-mail. Presentation should be with the support of MS Powerpoint.
3. **Each Team will be provided a total of 12 Minutes (10 Minutes for the Presentation and 02 Minutes for the Product Launch Video)**
4. The Product Launch Video should not exceed 2 Minutes
5. Presentation and video will be followed by an Interview with the Panel of Judges
6. **The date, time and link to join the finals will be sent to the selected candidates to the registered email ids.**

The Presentations will be evaluated based on the Comprehension, Novelty of the Idea, Feasibility, Team Effort and Dynamics, Creativity and the concept conveyed through the launch video.

If the number of teams registering for the event is less than three, the event will be held but only consolation prizes will be awarded to the participants.

Event 4: LES DEUX DANSEURS (SYNCHRO- DANCE)

Maximum number of participants per team: 2

Characteristics and Movements: The fundamental element of the discipline is to dance side by side in synchronization; therefore, all dancers must execute their movements and figures at the same time and in the same direction, maintaining their alignment throughout the performance. (The last 15-20 seconds may incorporate free alignment as a finale to the performance.)

The Synchro- dance event will take place at two levels:

Preliminary:

- **Participant Limit:** Two
- **Time Limit:** Minimum 2 mins 30 secs. and maximum 3 mins.
- **Music:** Participants may choose their own songs.
- **Video Format:** Add your Name_Event_College (Dave_Synchrodance_ABCCollege) in the video file. The files should be submitted as .mp4 or .mov. (No other format will be accepted).
- **Camera Style:** Dance video to be filmed horizontally or landscape (instead of vertical angle, if filming with phone).
- **Censorship:** Dance video and Song selection must not involve any vulgar use of language or topics. Choreography with topics that include religious characteristics, sexual innuendo, aggression of every kind (verbal, through poetry, music or visual, or through simulation), will be considered inappropriate.
- **Costume and Make-up:** Participants must choose costumes appropriate to their selected song.
- **Lifts / Acrobatic Movements / Contacts:** Not permitted.
- **Stage Props:** Not permitted.
 - **Prohibitions:** Removal of articles of clothing or accessories during the exhibition or while entering or exiting the floor.
 - The entries should be sent to the mentioned email id on or before **05.00 pm**, on **08-11-2020**.

Final:

- **Only the selected participants from Level- 1 will be allowed to perform live in Level- 2.**
- **For any technical glitch, the organizers can change the rule/cancel the level and the winners be selected from the entries made in the preliminary level.**
- **Live Performance:** The finalists must perform an impromptu dance of 3 minutes on stage (via online).
- **Music:** The songs will be selected by the organizers and played at the moment of the dance.
- **Costume and Make-up:** Finalists must choose their costume and make-up according to the accepted norms of propriety.
- **Lifts / Acrobatic Movements / Contacts:** Not permitted.
- **Stage Props:** Not permitted.
- **Prohibitions:** Removal of articles of clothing or accessories during the exhibition or while entering or exiting the floor.
- **The date, time and link to join the finals will be sent to the selected candidates to the registered email ids.**

JUDGMENT CRITERIA:

- Judgement will be based on unique moves, variety, quality of dance, and its execution.
- Judgement will also be based on for synchronisation, creativity, expression, costume, and make-up and overall effects.
- Choreography with topics that include religious characteristics, sexual innuendo, the aggression of every kind (verbal, through poetry, music or visual, through simulation), will be considered inappropriate. The decision on the disqualification of these performances will be made by the organizer.
- The decision of judges shall be final and binding.

Event 5: LE MEILLEUR (Tagline Competition)

Maximum number of participants per team: 1

Preliminary Round:

1. Candidates can create a new tagline for an existing brand and create a video of maximum 2 minutes explaining the concept behind it.
2. The tagline should not hurt anyone's emotion or contain any obscene content, double meaning. If anything objectionable is detected, the candidate will be disqualified.
3. 6 participants will be short listed.
4. The entries should be sent to the mentioned email ids on or before **5.00 pm on 08-11-2020.**

Final round:

1. The selected candidates should come up with the best tagline for the product assigned to them.
2. The new tagline should be completely your own.
3. One hour is assigned for the completion of the competition.
4. Each candidate will be given 5 mins. for presentation (live). Based on their presentations the candidates are expected to answer questions by the Judges.
5. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.
6. **The date, time and link to join the finals will be sent to the selected candidates to the registered email ids.**

If the number of teams registering for the event is less than three, the event will be held but only consolation prizes will be awarded to the participants.

Event 6: LE MEILLEUR DÉBATEUR (Turncoat)

Maximum number of participants per team: 1

Preliminary:

1. Turncoat is a debate event where the speaker literally debates against oneself for a duration of 3 minutes. The speaker shall speak in favour of the topic for 1 minute, against for 1 minute and sum up in the last 1 minute.
2. The participation is on individual basis.
3. The language to be used is English.
4. For the preliminary round, the candidate should speak on the given topic and the videos should be sent to the mentioned email ids before **5.00 pm on 08 – 11-2020. The topic will be sent to the registered participants on 05-11-2020.**
5. The finals will be held as a live session where the finalists will be given the topic 10 minutes prior to the performance of the candidate.

Finals:

6. In the finals the candidate should speak in favour of the topic for 2 minutes, against for 2 minutes and sum up in the last 1 minute.
7. **The date, time and link to join the finals will be sent to the selected candidates to the registered email ids.**
8. The judgement shall be based on the following criteria :
 - ✓ Content - Precise and related to the topic
 - ✓ Physical presence - Eye contact, body language and poise.
 - ✓ Voice and articulation - Volume, pace, rhythm, intonation and proper pronunciation.
 - ✓ Language - Appropriateness and accurate use of language.

The decision of the judges shall be final.

Event 7: LA PHOTOGRAPHIE (Photography)

Maximum number of participants per team: 1

1. The theme will be sent to the candidates registered email ids on **05 – 11-2020**.
2. Only one submission per participant is allowed. The same photo cannot be submitted more than once.
3. The participant should send a selfie from the same location.
4. Both the photograph and the selfie should have the timestamp.
5. Photographs should be submitted within the prescribed time period to the given email.
6. Submissions will not be accepted once the deadline lapses.
7. The images should be in the **.jpeg format only**.
8. Advanced editing used to create illusions, deceptions and/or manipulations, and the addition and removal of significant elements within the frame is prohibited.
9. Submitted photos must be original taken by the contestant.
10. Photos that portray or otherwise include inappropriate and/or offensive content, including provocative nudity, violence, human rights and/or environmental violation, and/or any other contents deemed to be contrary to the law, religious, cultural & moral traditions and practices of India, are strictly prohibited and will be immediately discarded.
11. Only DLSR cameras are allowed.
12. The decision of the judges shall be final
13. The entries should be sent to the mentioned email ids on or before **5.00 pm on 08-11-2020**.

Event 8: CAMOUFLAGE (Mask Designing)

Maximum number of participants per team: 1

Preliminary Round

1. The contestants have to send a hyperlapse video showing the process of designing the mask with the candidate's face.
2. Video submissions must be in .mp4 or .mov for mat and should have sufficient clarity, making it indisputably evident that the submission is wholly the work of the entrant.
3. Each entry must clearly state the name of the participant, the institution and Category (School or College).
4. The entries will be judged on the basis of originality, creativity and design.
5. The participants should use a plain mask (having no marks like in the image attached) of human likeness (any gender).
6. The candidates are free to use any items to draw, color or decorate the design.
7. Ten submissions adjudged the best will be selected for the final round.
8. The entries should be sent to the mentioned email ids on or **before 5.00 pm on 08-11-2020.**

Finals

1. The finals will be conducted live (The platform will be intimated to those selected, in due time). The contestants should keep the camera on throughout the event.
2. The participants should use a plain mask (having no marks like in the image attached) of human likeness (any gender).
3. The decision of the judges shall be final.
4. **The date, time and link to join the finals will be sent to the selected candidates to the registered email ids.**

If the number of teams registering for the event is less than three, the event will be held but only consolation prizes will be awarded to the participants.

Event 9: MON HISTOIRE (Short Story Telling)

Maximum number of participants per team: 1

1. Only one individual can perform in the story telling process.
2. Storytelling can be done either in English or Malayalam.
3. The maximum duration of the video is 5 minutes.
4. The theme of the short story will be send to the registered participants in the registered email id on **5 November 2020**.
5. Participants need to send a video of their storytelling (based on the given theme) to the organizers on or before **5.00 pm on 8 November 2020**.
6. The story telling video will be judged based on the presentation of the story and the adherence to the theme.
7. Participants may take either an adopted story or a self-written story for storytelling.
8. Participants are allowed to tell only one story in the given time, mixed stories are not allowed.
9. Participants are not allowed to read out the story.
10. No background music/sounds should be there for enhancing the story telling, the presence of which will disqualify the contestant from the competition.
11. The decision of the judges will be final.

Event 10: METTEUR EN SCÈNE (Film making challenge)

Maximum number of participants per team: 8 (excluding actors)

1. The event is a typical film-making challenge in which the teams should create a complete film (pre-production, production and post-production) **within the given 72 hours** based on the theme/topic given.
2. The winners will be awarded first and second prizes only.
3. Any number of teams from the same institution can participate in the event.
4. The participant teams should submit the ‘**behind the scenes**’ pictures **with time stamp** as the proof of the making process.
5. The video should be submitted (via google drive) within the given time; failing which will lead to the disqualification of the team.
6. The content should be appropriate; vulgarity and obscenity (appearance on screen or dialogues) will not be entertained.
7. **Language:** English or any other regional languages. **For all languages other than English, the subtitle is mandatory.** The language of the film should be stated clearly in the file mentioned in rule 9. The language will not be an aspect of consideration since the event focuses more on the 'making' aspects of the movie.
8. A file (preferably a Word document) should be uploaded along with the film, which contains details such as the title of the movie, language, list of the participants (full name) along with a photograph, name of the team/institution, role of the registered participants (excluding actors).
9. **Participants:** Min 4 to Max 8 participants (excluding actors). The role of each participant (as listed in the file mentioned in rule 9) should be reflected in the title credits of the film as well.
10. The theme of the competition will be announced on 5 November 2020, to all the registered candidates.
11. The event starts at 2:00pm on 05.11.2020 and ends at 2:00 pm on 08.11.2020.
12. The entries along with the required document file should be sent to the mentioned email id before 3:00 pm on 08.11.2020.
13. Duration: 3 minutes (minimum) to 10 minutes (maximum).
14. **Judgment Criteria:**
 - a. **Originality:** The content and presentation will be judged based on originality and creativity. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited.

- b. **Production:** The proper use of lights, sound, and location utilized to enhance the narration will be judged.
- c. Judgment will be based on the quality of narration, acting, characterization and direction.

15. Video Format: The video file must be sent in the format as **NAME, EVENT, YOUR COLLEGE (Dan_Filmmaking_ABCCollege)** in an **MP4, MOV**. (No other formats can be used).
